

Sambrano Dress Code

(Uniforms are required)

All of Sambrano Elementary School students shall be required to conform to the school dress code as detailed below:

Shirt

1. Must be short or long-sleeved polo shirt with a collar.
2. The only insignia allowed are San Elizario logos.
3. Shirts must be navy blue in color.
4. Shirts must fit appropriately, may not be oversized, and **must be tucked in at all times.**
5. There should be no blousing of the shirt to intentionally cover the belt area.
6. Over-bloused shirts may not be worn to purposely cover the uniform shirt.

Pants

1. Pants must be khaki or Docker-style twill or chino fabric. "Dickies" brand will not be allowed.
2. Pants must not be oversized or skin tight, they must fit at the waist and be worn at the waist.
3. **NO** cargo pants (pockets along the legs, **no** Capri style pants, **no** bell bottoms)
4. Pants must be khaki in color.
5. Baggy or saggy pants **will not** be permitted (must not be lower than the heel of the shoe).
6. Cut-off or unhemmed pants are unacceptable.
7. Belts worn with the school pants **cannot** have initial buckles and should be as simple as possible (e.g. no studs, spikes)

Shorts/Skorts/Skirts

1. Shorts/skorts/skirts must be khaki-style or Docker-style.
2. They must be khaki in color.
3. They may **not** be more than **three inches** above the knee. If this becomes a problem, shorts, skorts and skirts will not be allowed.

Coats

1. Coats, sweaters, or jackets not longer than hip length may be worn over the uniform shirt during the colder months.
2. Must not have any insignia except for San Elizario logos.
3. Trench coats are not allowed.
4. Flannel shirts or jackets are not allowed.

Shoes

1. Students are encouraged to wear athletic or casual-dress footwear.
2. Steel-toed shoes, flip-flops, or house shoes (e.g. slippers) are **not** allowed.
3. Shoes that leave scuffmarks are strongly discouraged.
4. Absolutely no bare feet (shoes or sandals must be worn at all times)!

Misc.

1. Piercing is only allowed on girls' ears.
2. Excessive jewelry is not allowed. Jewelry that reflects gangs, gothic, or para military is not allowed.
3. Hair must be any color that naturally occurs in humans (unnatural colors are not allowed e.g. bright blues, pinks, reds, oranges, purples, etc.).
4. Bandanas may not be worn on the head or displayed from the pocket.
5. Chains may not be used as belts or to secure wallets.
6. Belts with initial buckles may not be worn (associated with gang membership).
7. Hats/caps may not be worn in school building. Headbands, bandanas, and hairnets are not allowed.
8. Any other apparel, which an administrator determines to be inappropriate or identified as gang-related, will not be permitted.

All **parents** should ensure that their child adheres to the campus dress code, as it is enforced at all times. The school administration will continue to encourage all students to dress in a fashion that reflects good taste and style appropriate for the school environment. Your assistance in enforcing this policy will provide a better learning environment and curtail discipline problems within the campus. Parents will be called to bring proper attire if students are dressed inappropriately.
